Vineyard Details

The majority of the vineyards are located in the northeastern part of Coonawarra, at the warmer end of the region, with a small contribution from a vineyard in northern Coonawarra. These vineyards have a mixture of red loam over limestone and ironstone. The vines are 30 to 35 years old and machine-picked.

Winemaking Notes

Fermented in small stainless steel tanks for 7 days, these blends are from select barrels that are from our top end Coonawarra growers of the vintage.

Oak Maturation

New and used French oak with a small percentage of American oak. 300 litre barrels approx 12 months in oak.
