Nose

Lifted bramble, blackberry hints cedar.

Palate

Blackberry and blueberry flavours on the palate with subtle well integrated oak. These flavours are carried by gentle tannins that are long and fine giving a generous varietal finish.

Full bodied, balance oak elegant finish.

Food Match

Thick cut rump steak with butter sauce.

Vineyard Details

This is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon from premium vineyards across Coonawarra: 35% from the Glenroy sub-region on Terra Rossa, 20% from the eastern edge of the Coonawarra strip also on Terra Rossa, and 45% from the central Coonawarra Terra Rossa strip. All these vineyards contribute to the complexity of this wine, each bringing its own unique characteristics.

Winemaking Notes

Fermented in small stainless steel tanks for 7 days, these blends are from select barrels that are from our top end Coonawarra growers of the vintage.

Old Maturation

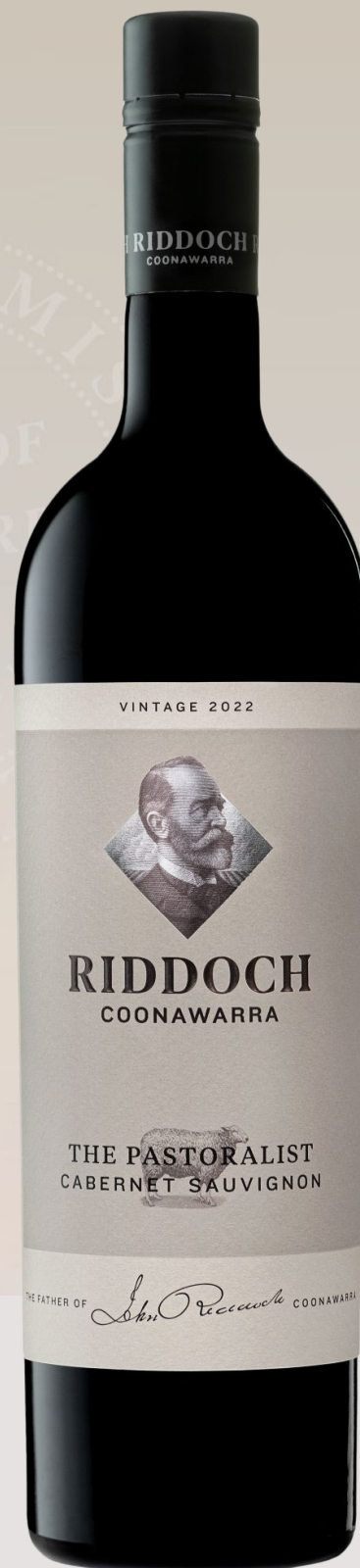
New and used French oak from premium barrel suppliers, 12 months barrel maturation.
